The aid animal must remain leashed or harnessed. You should prepare an evacuation kit for your aid animal and bring it you. Items to include in Emergency Evacuation Kit:

- Animal Identification (tag on collar/harness, microchip)
- Water and drinking bowl if desired.
- Cleaning supplies for animal waste (wipes, disinfectant, garbage bag)
- Leash, collar or harness
- Medications (if animal is on medication)

NOTE: You will be responsible for the actions of your aid animal.
